The Ofsted Framework – what we know

- Gradings remain (Outstanding, Good, etc)
- Judgements:
 - Quality of Education
 - Behaviour & Attitudes
 - Personal Development
 - Leadership & Management
- Focus on off-rolling
- Safeguarding does *not* go away!
- Section 8 inspections – two days

Section 8 Inspections

Inspectors will focus primarily on the 'quality of education' during a section 8 inspection of a good or non-exempt outstanding school.

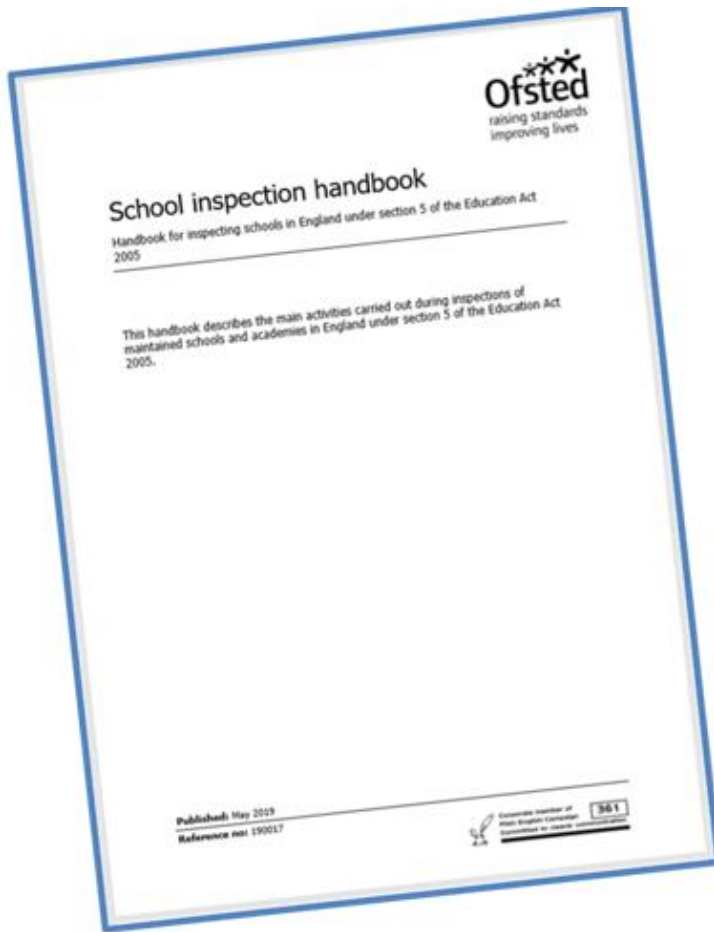

New Ofsted – what you may not

know

- *transition arrangements are in place – for judging the curriculum*
- enabling inspectors to make a *best-fit* judgement
- they *only* apply to potential *good* judgement for Q of Education
- inspectors will consider if the school's actions are likely to result in a good judgement within **two years**, *all other things being equal*.
- the same applies to Section 8 inspections of good schools

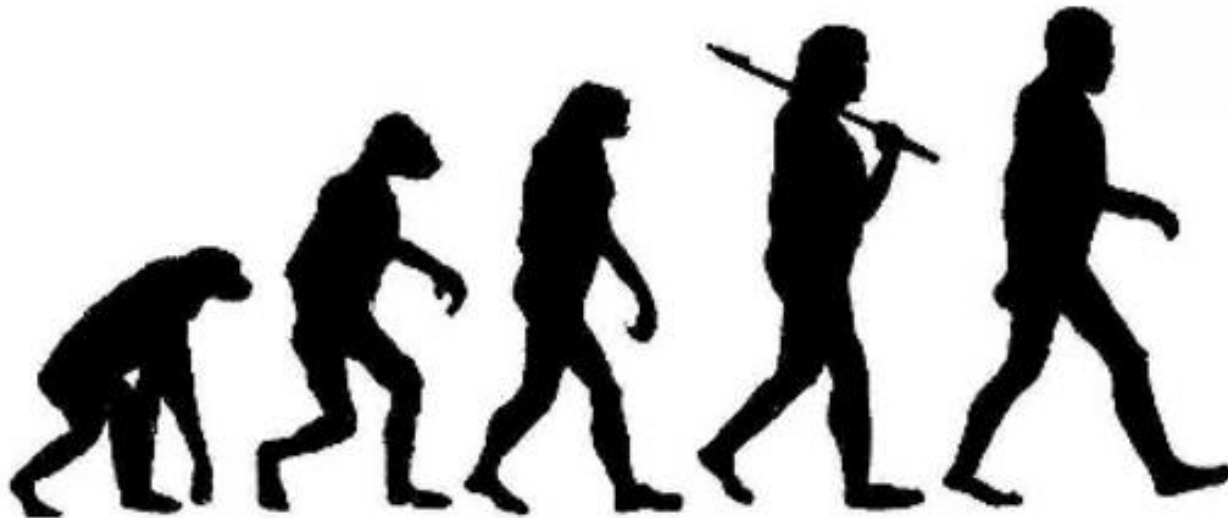

- Pupil progress in *knowing more, remembering more and being able to do more*
- Performance data
- Talking to pupils, work scrutiny
- Destination data (where relevant)
- Reading (primary only)
- SEND
